Ashton on Mersey Cricket and Tennis Club **Code of Conduct for Members and Guests**



- *Equality - Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person within the Club Treat everyone equally and do not discriminate on the grounds of age, gender, religion, race, sexual orientation or disability. If you see any form of discrimination do not condone it or allow it to go unchallenged*
- *Display high standards of language, manner, and presentation*
- *Do not smoke within the building (post July 2007)*
- *Do not use banned or illegal substances on the premises*
- *Bar and Bar Cellar - These areas are not to be accessed at any time by any member of Guest other than Club Management Committee officers or official Bar Staff.*
- *Functions - The club wishes to present a positive image of itself and its membership at all times. We are frequently visited by potential function customers, function guests, parents of juniors and visitors from other clubs. All members and guests must conduct themselves in a manner conducive with this aim and be aware of the negative impact of poor language or behavior.*
- *Food Consumption - ALL take-away food packaging must be disposed in the skip outside the club, not left lying around in the bar lounge or put in the lounge bins. In addition where a function is taking place at the club no take-away food should be brought in.*
- *Club Rules / Discipline - Failure to comply with these rules may lead to a temporary suspension from club activities, especially when the safety and welfare of others is compromised. In extreme circumstances, frequent transgressions may lead to expulsion from the Club.*
- *Subscriptions – should be paid on time. Any Member shall be considered lapsed who has not paid a subscription by June 1st each year.*
- *Décor – Do not put feet on chairs or tables, drawing pins should be put ONLY on official notice boards and not in the walls.*
- *Violence – The club has a zero tolerance policy towards violence of any kind on these premises.*
